DID YOU KNOW?

Did you know that the RVCA runs a routine water quality monitoring program for the watershed?

Water quality monitoring helps identify areas of pollution. This allows us to work with our partners in improving riverside practices for the long-term health of the river and its residents.

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?

Your project must be located in the Rideau Valley Watershed outside the City of Ottawa. See map on back.

FARMERS must have an approved Environmental Farm Plan (EFP) and a Farm Registration Number.

RURAL LANDOWNERS are eligible for some projects. See chart on page three.

HOW TO APPLY?

Follow these steps:

- Contact the LandOwner Resource Centre for program information or access the application forms at www.rideauvalley.on.ca (under programs and services)
- ► Fill out an application form (with assistance from a program rep if needed)
- ► Submit completed application to the LandOwner Resource Centre Box 599, 5524 Dickinson Street Manotick Ontario K4M 1A5 613-692-2390 or 1-800-387-5304
 - Make sure to attach estimates/quotes and confirmation of EFP completion
 - Also include your Farm Business Registration Number
 - Non-farm applicants need to complete a Healthy Home Guide Booklet as part of an application
- Project proceeds upon committee approval
- ► Payment is issued upon completion of work and final inspection. Receipts must be provided.

Runoff Management

Properly managing wastewater runoff is very important. Clean water diversion, drain outlet protection, silo leachate control and proper milkhouse washwater disposal help reduce harmful nutrients, bacteria and unsafe materials from reaching the river. Dollars are also available for constructed wetlands that purify barnyard runoff.

Buffers and Windbreaks

Shoreline planting and windbreaks stabilize the shore keeping the soil on the ground and not in the water.









Erosion Contro

Grassed waterways filter out harmful pollutants and sediments from our waterways. Shoreline stabilization and planting reduce erosion and are easy ways to improve water quality.

Septic System Repair

Keeping septic systems working properly is good for everyone's health — yours, mine and the rivers'.

Livestock Restriction

Keeping livestock out of watercourses is a simple and inexpensive way to improve water quality. Fencing, alternate watering and restricted livestock crossings control erosion and help protect herd health.


